### Playground Expectations

#### General Behavior:

- Stay in the schoolyard
- Do not climb over, go under or go out of fences without permission.
- Do not talk to or leave with strangers
- Show good sportsmanship
- Take turns
- Do not push, shove, fight or play-fight
- Do not throw sand, snowballs, rocks or any hard or sharp objects

## Big Toys:

- Do not play tag or chase games on the equipment
- Do not walk on top of the monkey bars
- Do not 'chicken fight' on monkey bars
- Cross monkey bars in direction of arrows
- Slide on bottoms do not swing on top bar above swing

### Swings:

- Sit in the center; never stand or kneel
- Stop to get off; do not jump off a moving swing
- Push swings from the back only
- Swing back and forth; do not swing sideways or twirl swings

# Soccer Goals, Backstops or Playhouses:

Do not stand or climb on top of soccer goals or playhouses

#### Soccer:

- Play with one (1) ball per game
- Do not use body contact
- Ball is played with the feet only. Goalie is the only player allowed to use hands

## Skipping Ropes:

• Use for skipping only

#### Steps:

- Students are asked to stay off entrance steps unless entering or exiting school
- Students may sit on library/gym steps

#### Front Sidewalk:

• Students should not play in the area between the north and south entrances or on the front sidewalk in that area

## Hill: (Winter)

• Students should climb up to top from ends of hill and slide down middle sections. Sliding on bottoms only-must wear ski pants.

## Consequences for Inappropriate Playground Behavior:

- Walk with supervisor
- Time out along the school wall
- Restriction from specific play area

If administration intervention is required, student will be referred to the office and supervising staff will complete office referral.
